

**SELINGROVE BOROUGH
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
FOR THE
FFY 2025 CDBG PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given by the **Selinsgrove Borough Council** that it will hold a Public Hearing on **June 2, 2025**, at **7:00 pm**, in the **Council Chambers, One North High Street, Selinsgrove, PA**. This meeting is accessible to individuals with disabilities and/or for persons with Limited English Proficiency. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to discuss the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in general, the needs of **Selinsgrove Borough's** performance under the previously funded CDBG Program years, and to discuss the required Three – Year Community Development Plan of **Selinsgrove Borough**.

Selinsgrove Borough is expected to receive an allocation of approximately **\$111,915** of **FY 2025** CDBG funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. In addition, **Selinsgrove Borough** does not anticipate the receipt of program income during the **FY 2025** program year. At least 70% of the available funding must be used for activities which benefit low- and moderate-income persons. The proposed activities must benefit at least 51% low-moderate income persons in the service area to qualify as a low-moderate income project. The PA Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) anticipates the application submission deadline of **October 31, 2025**.

The following types of activities may be eligible for funding under the CDBG Program: water and sewer line replacement and improvements; housing rehabilitation; construction of affordable housing; construction/reconstruction of public/community facilities; recreational facilities; public services that are new or provide quantifiable increases in the delivery of services; street improvements; historic preservation; removal of architectural barriers; code enforcement; economic development; acquisition and relocation; clearance and demolition; and general administration, planning, audit if required, and preparation of the CDBG application.

If **Selinsgrove Borough** would undertake activities that result in the displacement of families or individuals, then the **County's** policy for minimizing such displacement would be in effect. **Selinsgrove Borough** is responsible for replacing all low- and moderate-income housing units that may be demolished or converted as a result of the use of CDBG funds.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend and will be offered the opportunity to give oral testimony at the Public Hearing and/or to present written comments concerning the needs of **Selinsgrove Borough's** proposed CDBG Program activities, the prior use of CDBG funds, as well as the CDBG Program in general, comments may be submitted to **Shannon Rudy, P.O. Box 217, Middleburg, PA 17842, or srudy@snydercounty.org by 3 pm, on June 2, 2025**.
