Install 28 Gauge G100 Corrugated ABM roofing panels (or equivalent)

Install Vented Ridge Caps on the peaks and rubber sealed ridge caps on the hips

Install Rake & Corner trim on the gables

All chimney, skylights and pipes will be flashed properly

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

(The following instructions shall be adhered to in the preparation of this proposal by the Bidder.)

1. DEFINITIONS.

- a. **Owner:** The term "Owner" as used in the Contract Documents refer to:

Questions pertaining to the specifications during the bidding period shall be made in writing and directed to the above office.

- b. **Contractor:** The term "Contractor" refers to the Contractor to who an award is made to perform the work under the Contract Documents.

2. PREPARATION OF PROPOSALS.

- a. Proposals shall be submitted on Form of Proposal attached hereto or on an exact copy thereof which contains identical language. All blank spaces on the form shall be fully completed in accordance with these instructions, without variation, and there shall be no interlineations, deletions, or additions. Bid price shall be stated both in writing and in figures and in case of discrepancy, written words shall be considered as being bid price. The bid of an individual must be signed by him, personally; his signature must be witnessed and his business address and any business trade name must be stated. The bid of a partnership must state the names and addresses of all partners, and the partnership business name and address; and it must be signed by at least one of the partners, with the signature witnessed. The bid of a corporation must show the state of incorporation and the principal office address, and must be signed (1) by the President or Vice-President with the corporate seal affixed, attested by the Secretary or Assistant Secretary, or (2) by a duly authorized agent of the corporation, proof of whose authority shall be attached.
1. Do not detach bid forms bound herein. Bid forms will be furnished to each prospective bidder. Submit bid in three copies; one fully executed to which bid security shall be affixed; second copy shall be a conformed copy affixed to the first copy; third copy for bidder's file.
- b. Proposals shall not contain any recapitulations of the work to be done. No oral, telegraphic or telephonic communications or modifications shall be considered.
- c. Proposals shall be addressed to the Owner whose name appears in paragraph 1.a. above; it shall be mailed or delivered to the address stated in the Advertisement, enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope marked with the names of the project and bidder; and must be received not later than the time designated in the Advertisement. No responsibility will attach to Owner for premature opening of the bid which is not properly identified.

3. DISCREPANCIES OR OMISSIONS: BIDDER'S RESPONSIBILITY.

- a. Bidders who find discrepancies in or omissions from the Specifications or who are in doubt as to their meaning should at once notify the Owner in writing. If it is deemed necessary, instructions in the form of Bulletins to Specifications will be issued to all bidders by U.S. Mail. Owner will not be responsible for any oral instructions. It will be assumed with the submission of the proposal that the bidder has fully examined the site and the Specifications and has made provisions for construction

under the conditions set forth; and the bidder is responsible for seeing that his proposed subcontractors are familiar with requirements of the Contract Documents so far as applicable to their work.

- b. Proposals shall be based upon Specifications and other documents constituting the Contract Documents referred to in the Advertisement bound herewith for a period of sixty (60) days after date set for receiving bids, except when mathematical, typographical or clerical mistakes are proved by clear and convincing evidence.
 - i. Any bidder may withdraw his proposal after it has been received by the Owner if the bidder shall make a request for withdrawal, in writing, and such a request shall be received by the Owner prior to the time specified in the Advertisement bound herewith for the opening of the Proposals.
 - ii. Any proposal which has been opened by the Owner may not be withdrawn during the period specified in the Advertisement bound herewith as the period during which proposals may not be withdrawn by bidders, except as specifically permitted by law.

4. BID SECURITY; FORFEITURE.

- a. Proposals shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or treasurer's check drawn on banks or trust companies insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or by a **BID BOND IN THE FORM PROVIDED IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS**, with corporate surety satisfactory to the Owner, in an amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the highest bid price, to be retained and applied as provided, in case the bidder should default in executing the Agreement and furnishing the required insurance certificates within ten (10) days after notice that an award has been made to him, or in case the bidder should default in furnishing the required Performance and Payment Bonds as required by the Contract Documents.
- b. Bid securities of the three lowest responsible bidders for each contract will be retained until Contract Documents have been properly executed by the bidder to whom the contract is awarded but in no event exceeding sixty (60) days after bid opening. All other bid securities will be submitted by bidder within ten (10) days after bid opening. In the event that a Bid Bond is submitted with the Proposal, the bidder shall make certain that a proper power of attorney evidencing the authority of the agent of the surety to execute the Bid Bond is furnished therewith.
- c. If a bidder to whom five (5) days' notice of intention to accept his proposal has been made by or on behalf of the Owner fails to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond in forms furnished herewith, as required by the laws of Pennsylvania, to the Owner, as a condition of precedent to formal award of the contract or fails to execute the Agreement or to furnish the required insurance certificates within ten (10) days after notice that an award has been made to him, the Owner may at its sole discretion, award the contract to the next lowest responsible bidder or re-advertise for bids, and the defaulting bidder shall pay to the Owner the difference between the amount of his bid and any higher amount for which the Owner may contract for the required work, plus any advertising, legal or other expenses incurred by reason of the default. The security check of such defaulting binder, or as the case may be, the amount recovered from the surety of such bidder on his Bid Bond shall be applied on account of said damages, and if the amount of said difference, plus such expense, shall exceed the amount of such check or recovery, the defaulting bidder shall pay to the Owner the full amount of the excess.

5. CONTRACT BOND.

Performance Bond and Payment Bond need not be submitted with the bidder's proposal. Compliance with requirements of Section 3 of the Public Works Contactors' Bond Law of 1967 will be achieved in the manner prescribed in the Contract Documents.

6. AWARD OF CONTRACT.

- a. Competency and responsibility of bidder including ability to complete the project within the time specified, will be considered in making award. Attached to proposal form is a questionnaire concerning bidder's qualifications which shall be completed and accompany his proposal. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive technicalities of informalities for its best interest. Proposals may be rejected if they show any omissions, alterations of form, additions, or deductions not called for, conditional or uninvited alternate bids, or irregularities of any kind. Proposals in which the prices are unbalanced may be rejected. Claims on account of mistakes in or omissions in bids will not be considerate, except as specifically permitted by law.
- b. Before awarding a contract, the Owner may require apparent lowbidder (for each contact) to qualify himself to be a responsible bidder by furnishing:
 - i. A financial statement showing assets and liabilities of bidder current to a date within thirty (30) days of date of opening bids.
 - ii. A listing of not less than three (3) completed projects of similar scope and nature.
 - iii. The number of regular employees of the organization and length of time organization has been in business under the present name.

Should the Owner adjudge that the apparent low bidder is not the lowest responsible bidder, said apparent low bidder will be notified and his bid security returned to him without prejudice.

- c. If awards are made, the Owner will execute the Agreement within ten (10) days after the Contractor executes and delivers same to Owner, accompanied by insurance certificates and Performance and Payment Bonds.
- d. Copies of Agreement, Performance Bond and Payment Bond forms included with these specifications exemplify type of contract forms that the successful bidder will be required to execute before or after award has been made, as contemplated by Contract Documents and as required by State law in case of such bonds. If the successful bidder is a foreign corporation, the Performance Bond and Payment Bond shall contain the further condition that neither such corporation nor its surety shall be discharged from liability upon said Performance Bond and Payment Bond until such corporation shall have filed with the Owner a certificate from the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue evidencing payment in full of all bonus taxes, penalties and interest, and a certificate from the Bureau of Employment.

7. CHANGES PRIOR TO OPENING OF PROPOSALS.

- a. During the period allowed for the preparation of bids, the Owner may furnish the prospective bidders bulletins setting forth additions to or alterations of the Contract Documents, which additions or alterations shall be included by each bidder in the computation of amounts to be inserted by him in the proposal which he submits and which bulletins shall become a part of such Contract Documents as if the same were fully incorporated herein.
- b. It shall be the duty of each prospective bidder to ascertain what bulletins, if any, have been issued by the Owner which may affect the work to be covered by his proposal, and to inform his prospective subcontractors thereof to the extent that they may be affected.
- c. Failure of any bidder to receive any bulletin as provided for in this paragraph shall not relieve such bidder from the obligation of his proposal.
- d. Any bulletin issued by the Owner will be mailed by U.S. Mail, or otherwise delivered, to each prospective bidder of whom the Owner shall have a record..

8. START OF WORK.

Work under contract for this project shall be commenced within five (5) days after notification to start has been given by Owner.

9. COMPLETION OF PROJECT.

Project shall be fully and finally completed within time specified in proposal, which time for completion shall be of the essence of the contract.

10. BONDS AND INSURANCE.

Requirements for Bonds and Insurance are stated in Conditions of Contract. Performance and Payment Bonds are required in amount of one hundred percent (100%) of contract price for each bond.

11. STATEMENT OF BIDDER'S QUALIFICATION.

Statement of bidder's qualifications, a copy of which is bound in this booklet following proposal forms, **must** be completely answered, dated, signed and sworn to, and **must accompany the proposal**.

12. DAVIS-BACON ACT.

1. SCOPE OF WORK.

The Contractor shall perform all of the labor and materials for the Borough Maintenance Shed Roof Replacement, and shall do everything required by this Agreement and Contract Documents. Such work shall specifically encompass the services and specifications set forth in the bid specifications of the Owner which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

2. TIME OF COMPLETION.

ARTICLE 1 – DEFINITIONS

Whenever used in these General Conditions or in the other Contract Documents, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated which shall be applicable to both the singular and the plural thereof:

Acceptance – Written notice by the Owner that the equipment and services complies with the specifications and that satisfactory performance has been demonstrated.

Agreement – The written Agreement between the Owner and the Contractor covering the services to be delivered. The Contract documents will be attached to and made a part of the Agreement.

Bid – The offer or proposal of the Bidder submitted on the prescribed form setting forth the prices and other criteria for the equipment and installation to be provided.

Bidder – Any person, firm, or corporation submitting a Bid for the roof repair work.

Bonds – The Bid Bond, the Payment Bond, the Performance Bond, and other instruments of security.

Change Order – A written order to the Contractor signed by the Owner authorizing an addition, deletion, or revision in the work, or an adjustment in the Contract Price or the Contract Time issued after the execution of the Agreement.

Contract Documents – The advertisement, Instructions To Bidders, Form Of Proposal, Bulletins, Statement Of Bidder's Qualifications, Agreement, Bonds, General Conditions, Program Requirements, and Change Orders, if any.

Contract Price – The total moneys payable to the Contractor under the Contract

Documents. Contract Time – The date stated in the Agreement for delivery of the services.

Contractor – The person, firm, or corporation with whom the Owner will execute the Agreement to deliver the equipment and perform its installation.

Notice Of Intent To Award – The written notice by the Owner to the Contractor that the Contractor is the apparent lowest responsible Bidder and that upon compliance with the conditions precedent to be fulfilled by the Contractor within the time specified, the owner will execute and deliver the Agreement.

Owner – Selinsgrove Borough, Snyder County, Pennsylvania

Specifications – The drawings and building plans together with written building terms and conditions.

ARTICLE 2 – COPIES OF DOCUMENTS

The Owner will furnish one copy of the Program Requirements to the Contractor free of charge. Additional copies will be furnished upon request at the cost of reproduction.

ARTICLE 3 – CORRELATION, INTERPRETATION AND INTENT OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

3.1. It is the intent of the Program Requirements to describe all of the services to be supplied in accordance with the Contract Documents. The Contract Documents comprise the entire agreement between the Owner and the Contractor and may only be altered by a Change Order.

Each and every provision by law and regulations to be inserted in the Contract Documents shall be deemed to be inserted herein, and the Contract Documents shall be read and enforced as though it were included herein. If through mistake or otherwise, any such provision is not inserted, or is not correctly inserted, then, upon the application of either party, the Contract Documents shall forthwith be altered to make such insertion.

ARTICLE 4 – PATENT FEES AND ROYALTIES

The Contractor shall pay all license fees and royalties and assume all costs incident to the use of any invention, design, process, or device which is the subject of patent rights or copyrights held by others. He shall indemnify and hold harmless the Owner and anyone directly or indirectly employed by the Owner from and against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses (including attorney's fees) arising out of any infringement of such rights and shall defend all such claims in connection with any alleged infringement of such rights.

ARTICLE 5 – CHANGES IN THE WORK, CONTRACT PRICE, CONTRACT TIME

5.1. The Owner may, at any time and without notice to any surety, by written order designated or indicated to be a Change Order, make any change in the work within the general scope of the Contract Documents, including, but not limited to, changes in:

Specification; Method or manner of performance of the work; or Directing acceleration in the delivery of the services required under the Program Requirements.

5.2. Any other written order or an oral order (which term as used in this paragraph, 5.2., shall include direction, instruction, interpretation, or determination) from the Owner which cause any such change, shall be treated as a Change Order under this clause, provided that the Contractor gives the Owner written notice stating the date, circumstances, and source of the order and that the Contractor regards the order as a Change Order.

5.3. Except as herein provided, no order, statement, or conduct of the Owner shall be treated as a change under this clause or entitle the Contractor to an equitable adjustment.

5.4. If any change under this clause causes an increase or decrease in the Contractor's costs of, or the time required for, the performance of any part of the work under the Contract Documents, whether or not changed by any order, and equitable adjustment shall be made and the Agreement modified in writing accordingly, provided, however, that except for claims based on defective program requirements, no claim for any change under paragraph 5.2. above shall be allowed for any costs incurred more than 20 days before the Contractor gives written notice as therein required, and provided further, that in the case of defective specifications for which the Owner is responsible, the equitable adjustment shall include any increased cost reasonably incurred by the Contractor in attempting to comply with such defective program requirements.

5.5. The Contractor intends to assert a claim for an equitable adjustment under this clause, he must, within 30 days after receipt of a written Change Order under paragraph 5.1. above or the furnishing of a written notice under paragraph 5.2. above, submit to the Owner a written statement setting forth the general nature and monetary extent of such claim, unless this period is extended by the Owner. The statement of the claim hereunder may be included in the notice under paragraph 5.2. above.

ARTICLE 6 – DELIVERY

The Contractor shall provide all services in Snyder Counties and surrounding areas.

ARTICLE 7 – WARRANTY AND GUARANTEE

The Contractor warrants and guarantees to the Owner that all services shall be of good quality and free from faults or defects and in accordance with the requirements of the Contract Documents. All unsatisfactory, faulty, or defective services or services not conforming to the requirements of the Contract Documents or to inspection, tests or approvals, shall be considered defective. Prompt notice of all defects shall be given to the Contractor.

ARTICLE 8 – OWNER’S WARRANTY

The Owner warrants and guarantees that it is the fee simple title holder of the Premises which serves as the site for the performance of the Agreement.

ARTICLE 9 – PAYMENTS

Payments to the Contractor shall be made as indicated in the Agreement.

ARTICLE 10 – SALES TAX

Pennsylvania Sales Tax shall not apply to the services supplied to Owner under this contract.

ARTICLE 11 – CIVIL RIGHTS PROVISION
